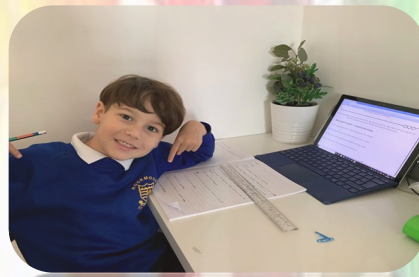

Home Learning



Where a class or group of pupils need to self-isolate, or local restrictions require pupils to remain at home, we will offer high-quality immediate remote education which is aligned as closely as possible with in-school provision.

Self Isolation



If a child or group of children are self isolating, staff will assign work to Google Classroom closely linked to what is being taught. Assignments will be kept in a topic folder called 'Self-Isolation Work' which can be found in the 'Classwork Tab'. Staff will give specific feedback related to the learning on any work 'Turned in'.

Lockdown



If there is a local restriction or a total lockdown which requires children to remain at home, staff will provide daily online learning. Staff will regularly update the 'Stream' which children can also comment on. You will find work related to English, Maths, the wider curriculum and links to useful websites. Work will be regularly updated and feedback will be given.



Google Meet

Google Meet is a video communication tool that will ensure children have regular interactions with school staff. If there is a local restriction or a total lockdown which requires pupils to remain at home, staff will conduct a morning Google Meet with groups of children to introduce the learning for the day. Staff will also conduct an afternoon Google Meet with groups of children to introduce afternoon learning and provide feedback on work completed during the morning session.



Homework & Spellings

Staff will ensure that timely homework and spellings are available on Google Classroom. You can use the Google Classroom to view the homework & spelling documents or create and 'Turn In' homework using Google Drive. You can also email homework to staff using your year group email address. All homework will be checked and feedback given on Google Classroom.
